## STUDENT PROGRESS COMMITTEE

The Student Progress Committee will be chaired by the Chair of Primary Care. The Associate Dean of Academic Affairs and a minimum of three faculty members, to include at least one primary care clinical faculty member, one specialty clinical faculty member, and one biomedical faculty member will comprise the remaining members of the committee. The Dean appoints the faculty members. A quorum is defined as a simple majority of members present in person or by teleconference.

The committee is charged with monitoring the academic progress of students, identifying students who would benefit from additional faculty support, and evaluating academic issues regarding students including issues related to professionalism. The committee is responsible for making decisions related to student accommodation, continued matriculation, promotion, retention, discipline, corrective action plans, and student dismissal. Furthermore, the committee is responsible for putting forward a recommended list of graduates each year and submitting that list to the Faculty Body for vote. Lastly, the committee is responsible for putting forward a recommended list of students for any academic-related awards, honors, or nominations each year and submitting that list to the Faculty Body for vote.
