COMLEX-USA Pass Rates

The Meritus School of Osteopathic Medicine is committed to transparency and accountability in publishing performance outcomes for the National Board of Osteopathic Medical Examiners (NBOME) COMLEX-USA® examination series. Beginning with its inaugural cohort, MSOM will provide first-time pass rates for COMLEX-USA Level 1, Level 2-CE, and Level 3. These data will be updated promptly — within 30 days of MSOM's receipt of the annual NBOME cycle results — and will be displayed on a publicly accessible page for faculty, students, applicants, and the community.

To support meaningful interpretation of the data, MSOM also presents the methodological details and defines key terms. The "first-time pass rate" refers to the percentage of MSOM students who passed on their first attempt during the NBOME testing cycle. NBOME testing cycles typically span May 1 through April 30 for most levels. MSOM's methodology includes verifying student outcomes with NBOME reports, rounding to the nearest whole percentage point, and clearly marking forthcoming data as "TBA" when available results have not yet been finalized.
